While designed to be user friendly to those parking, Durham must pay Ventek for the use of the kiosk. In the fall of 2023 we introduced pay by plate kiosks. This will increase the use of credit cards. We also have to pay a transaction fee each time the kiosk is used. The cost of the wireless is included through the credit card system, but the expense has been significant as the vast majority of users are extracting banking fees absorbed by this line. Last year costs doubled as the use of the machines via credit cards soared.
