**Town Council Update.** James absent, no update given.

**Planning Board Update** by Paul. Still working on housing ordinance.

**DPW Update.** Sam absent due to truck problems.

**Compost Challenge Update** by Julie and Will.

- Three weeks of Challenge have been completed.
- Will, Julie, and Mike spoke with 40-50 people at Transfer Station.
- One resident, Pete, previously lived in Brattleboro and helped implement a pilot compost program. Brattleboro's population is 7500-12000, similar in size to Durham. We will invite Pete to attend future meeting.
- Challenge participants reported that habit-change is their biggest hurdle.
- Possible ways to make it easier to bring compost to TS, given the limited hours:  
Encourage people to bring neighbors' compost? Have collection bin at gate when TS is closed?

**Hannaford Followup.** Susan will draft letter to Robin and George thanking them and suggesting next steps to promote reusable bag use, both in produce section and at checkout.
