I. Call to Order

VIII. **Public Hearing - Updating the HDC Ordinance.** Proposed zoning amendment to update the old Map and Lot numbers to the current ones in the Historic District Ordinance. Requested by **the Historic District Commission. Recommended action:** Vote to initiate the amendment.

The Planning Board voted unanimously to initiate the amendment. It will be forwarded now to the Town Council.

IX. <u>Workforce Housing – Potential Zoning Amendment</u>. Discussion about rough draft (second iteration) of a proposed workforce housing ordinance.

There was substantial discussion about several variables – what percentage of units should be affordable, whether to use a tiered system with incentives to provide a higher percentage of affordable units or units affordable to those with less income, whether units should be for sale or only for rent, whether single-family houses should be included, and whether rents should be set based on HUD Fair Market Rent Levels. The discussion was continued to July 10.

X. <u>Zoning Rewrite – Table of Uses</u>. Discussion about possible changes to the Table of Uses in the Zoning Ordinance, reviewed as part of the ongoing Zoning Rewrite. <u>Recommended action</u>: Discussion about possible changes.

The board did not get to this item.

XI. Other Business

• Discuss whether to change the definition of "Household" which includes "Family" in the Zoning Ordinance

The board started this discussion. The discussion was continued probably to July 10.

Board members Peyton and Tom will continue working on a proposal for workforce housing in the downtown area.
