SUGGESTIONS:

- ★ Hold owners to Town site plan planting regulations and wetland/shoreland setbacks;
- ★ Specify detailed site preparation and planting procedures, including soil media and soil volume;
- ★ Ensure that species lists prefer sustainable native plants in natural vertical layers of vegetation;
- ★ Include warranteed vegetation maintenance for three years minimum; and owner to guarantee provisions for long-term maintenance of vegetation.
