**Subject:** 56 Main Street Construction staging

I meet with Doug Clark and Pete Murphy today to discuss the staging and storage of construction material for 56 Main Street, AKA the old Durham Flower Shop and agreed to the following:

- Fencing from the corner of the building along the curbing heading north on Jenkins Court to the driveway where there would be a break at the driveway, will be installed. The next three spaces on the same side will have additional fencing essentially creating a fenced-in rectangle securing this area for storage of construction material storage. The sidewalk in front of these three spaces would be accessible at all times.
- There will be significant construction on the side of 56 Main Street where the attached shed and stairs will be removed in essence closing the entire sidewalk adjacent to the building, hence the necessity to secure by fencing.
- Construction should be completed by the middle of August restoring the secure spaces to the Town's inventory.
- No parking spaces were provided for construction workers
