- 1. My understanding is that no other UNH fraternity is under the same restrictions at this time,
- 2. Yes, substantial objections. Given the incident at SAE early in the Spring 2019 semester, I cannot support easing those restrictions. Moreover, I conveyed to Chief Kurz last Friday that, given the apparent presence of alcohol in a common area within SAE at a gathering of approximately 120 students at an unauthorized social event, I would not object to a review of the incident by the Town of Durham code enforcement, and
- 3. Please use me as your primary contact for matters such as this one.

Fraternity & Sorority Life (FSL) at UNH enjoys good leadership and guidance from Jamie Silverstein, its director. She, I, and others work collaboratively to strengthen our FSL system and our productive relationship with the Town.
