TO: Durham Conservation Commission

As a result of a Superior Court judgement, you will again be dealing with the proposed Gerrish project and the Gerrish Wetlands which would need to be destroyed to accommodate the applicant's proposed access road through the Gerrish Wetlands. An official HISS map, properly certified, is being developed as a result of the Court order. It is important that we are all presented with a proper HISS map, one that corresponds to Mr. Mariano's 2018 narrative report, and not a purported one done in 2020 that is inconsistent with that narrative report. It is incumbent upon you, therefore, the members of the Conservation Commission, to carefully consider ALL of the Mulhern property, and, as well, to do a site walk on the Bagdad Access in order to properly issue to the Planning Board findings and recommendations on the ecological and hydrological impacts of this application to their full degree.
