PARTICIPANTS NEEDED



Individuals ages 50+ with or without Parkinson's disease for a study comparing reaction times and cognitive functioning.

- We are seeking relatively healthy English speaking individuals living independently in the community.
- Participants must have normal vision, or corrected with glasses or contacts, in order to view a computer screen.
- All participants must be free from serious chronic medical illnesses other than Parkinson's disease, and be free from serious cardiac or musculoskeletal issues that may impede upper limb movement.
 Participants with Parkinson's disease having severe depression will also be excluded from participating.

TIME COMMITMENT: Two sessions, for about 2.5 hours per session.

WHERE: University of New Hampshire, Durham, NH.

IMPORTANCE: Data obtained will allow scientists to better understand neurological and behavioral changes occurring in adults with or without Parkinson's disease.
